

Canada Post strike update

May 31, 2011

Canada Post has indicated that the Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW) bargaining team has provided them the 72 hours notice required for their right to strike. CUPW will be able to strike as of 11:59 pm June 2, 2011 if a settlement has not been reached by this time.

RBC Dexia Investor Services is closely monitoring the situation and we are currently working to mitigate any impact a potential Canada Post strike might have on your service.

If a strike occurs, all cheques issued after June 2 will be held in our office until the work disruption has been resolved.

If you receive your monthly pension payment through direct deposit, there will be no impact to your payment in the event of a strike. However, your Direct Deposit Advice will only be mailed once the Canada Post work disruption has been resolved.
